sunflowers were cultivated around 3000 B.C. by native Americans in current-day Arizona and New Mexico. Among native American tribes, sunflower seeds were ground up and used as flour and some tribes would mix the flour with various vegetables. Sunflowers were also used medicinally to treat snakebites and the oil was used for skin and hair.

The dried stalks of sunflowers were used as building materials and the seeds were used in ceremonies. In the late 19th century, sunflower seeds made their way to the united states and were commercial food for poultry. In 1930, Canada created the first official sunflower breeding program.
